Resolutions

At the ISO/TC 37/SC 4 plenary meeting, 2009-05-31, University of Colorado, Boulder, Colorado, U.S.A., chaired by Nicolleta Calzolari for Laurent Romary, the following resolutions were adopted:

1. Action items on balloting

Resolution 2009-01:

It is resolved that, having been unanimously approved as FDIS on 2008-12-13 with 14 out of 14 voting P-members positively voting, the final version of DIS 24610-2 Language resource management – Part 2: Feature system declaration be submitted for publication to ISO/CS without undergoing the intermediate stage of FDIS.

Resolution 2009-02:

It is resolved that, having been unanimously approved as FDIS on 2009-04-08 with 17 out of 17 voting P-members positively voting, the final version of DIS 24617-1 Language resource management – Part 1: Time and events be submitted for publication to ISO/CS without undergoing the intermediate stage of FDIS.
